## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

### **DEFINITIONS**

DLC – Design Light Consortium

ESC – Energy Solutions Centre

Fixture or luminaire – a complete electric light unit

Lamp – a replaceable component that produces light from electricity

**ELIGIBILITY:** Owners or lease holders of commercial or institutional buildings in Yukon. Commercial buildings are buildings in which the primary activity conducted within the building is business or commerce. Institutional buildings are buildings that are community-owned and operated for public purposes, such as municipal or First Nation government buildings or recreation centres. Yukon and federal government buildings are not eligible.

The LED Lighting Upgrade for Commercial Buildings and Thermal Enclosure Upgrade for Multi-Family Building Incentives are limited to one upgrade per building or business per year.

**ELIGIBLE PRODUCTS:** [ENERGY STAR®](#), [Design Light Consortium-qualified](#) and [IDA Fixture Seal of Approval](#) LED lamps and fixtures.

Dark-Sky approved is defined as lamps / fixtures that are fully shielded, have a nominal correlated colour temperature (CCT) of 2,700K or warmer, and do not exceed a manufacturer-stated nominal CCT of 3,000K. Fully shielded is defined as a luminaire constructed and installed in such a manner that all light emitted by the luminaire, either directly from the lamp or a diffusing element, or indirectly by reflection or refraction from any part of the luminaire, is projected below the horizontal plane through the luminaire's lowest light-emitting part.

Lighting controls, occupancy and photo sensors must be commercial-grade. Materials must be purchased within one year of submission date.

**RECEIPTS AND INVOICES:** Receipts and invoices must be legible, itemized and include: purchase date, purchaser name, retailer/supplier name, brands and model numbers of items purchased, description, and cost of individual components. **Invoices must have a zero balance or be noted “Paid in full” and initialed by the contractor.** Rebates are calculated at pre-tax material cost.

**LIMITS TO PROGRAM:** The Good Energy program is renewed annually pending fiscal year budget allocation. Rebate offers are subject to program funding and revision and may change or end at any time. In no event will a rebate amount exceed the product, project or service value.

**SUBMISSION AND PAYMENT:** ESC is not responsible for lost, late, incomplete or ineligible submissions. Please allow up to eight weeks for payment. Payment may be direct deposit if you have been employed or under contract with Yukon government.

**QUALIFYING PRODUCTS:** ESC relies on third-party standards to identify and validate energy efficient products, projects and services. ESC does not endorse any particular manufacturer, supplier, contractor or installer in promoting these third-party standards.
